

# **DEAR FRIENDS AND SUPPORTERS,**

Reflecting on the past year, we are filled with mixed emotions. Just four months into our 2023-2024 fiscal year, we—along with the entire Jewish community and its allies—faced the unimaginable. Our thoughts, prayers, and actions turned to showing unwavering solidarity and support for the people of Israel following the attacks on October 7, 2023.

Through an effort spearheaded by the International Association of Jewish Free Loans, JFL Phoenix joined 15 North American free loan agencies to lend 3.4 million dollars to Ogen, our colleague agency in Israel. These funds were swiftly disbursed as interest-free emergency loans to Israeli individuals and families who were displaced from their homes or faced other economic challenges due to the war.

As the needs abroad grew, so too did the financial needs of our local Jewish community. During our 2023-2024 fiscal year, we saw a dramatic increase in demand for our services. We processed nearly 300 applications and responded to hundreds of inquiries via email and telephone. Many of these requests came from community members in extreme crisis, facing the threat of eviction.

For the first time in our nearly 75-year history, JFL made the difficult but necessary decision to focus solely on emergency loan requests during the second half of our fiscal year. JFL was there to assist households facing housing instability. Our interest-free loans not only halted the eviction process but also ensured safe housing and fostered financial stability, making a significant impact on the lives of the recipients.

This proactive approach to meeting the immediate needs of our community enabled the JFL Board of Directors and staff to engage in strategic planning processes to strengthen and safeguard JFL's present and future. The outcome includes restructured loan programs, an updated mission and vision, a newly created organizational values statement, and initiatives designed to address the current financial needs of our community while ensuring a sustainable resource for future generations.

Whether locally or internationally, the power, importance, and impact of interest-free lending are undeniable. With the support of our donors, partners, and community, JFL is committed to ensuring the availability and accessibility of interest-free financial assistance today and for many tomorrows to come.

Thank you for your support and dedication to our mission. Together, we are positively impacting lives through interest-free lending.

# **SUPPORTING ISRAEL**

#### STANDING IN SOLIDARITY

JFL Phoenix, along with the International Association of Jewish Free Loans and 15 other member agencies, provided a \$3.4 million interest-free loan to Ogen, our sister agency in Israel. This loan offered emergency assistance to 350 Israeli households displaced from their homes or facing economic challenges due to the war. The funds given to Ogen are interest-free and will eventually be returned to the participating cities for future local use.

#### HONORING LOCAL SOLDIERS

JFL supported the AZIDFHeroes program, a community initiative, by distributing funds to local Israeli reservists. This assistance helped them meet their financial obligations while they were serving in Israel.


